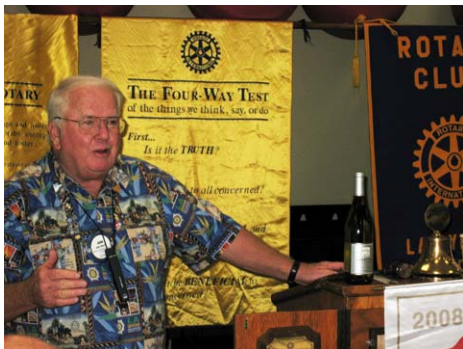


AARON WIGHT PINGREE
25 SEPT 1917 – 25 AUG 2008



Aaron passed away quietly on August 25, 2008 in his home, surrounded by his loving family. He was born to Aaron Thomas Pingree and Hazel (Wight) Pingree on September 25, 1917, in Ogden, Utah. He was 90 years, young at heart. On June 6th, 2008 he celebrated 65 years of marriage to Elfie. They lived in Lafayette for 62 years, where they built their home and raised their two children, Jim and Nancy. He and Elfie operated Fumble Fingers Lapidary Shop in Lafayette for 47 years. He was an avid fly fisherman, creative rock hound, lapidarian, builder, gardener, prospector, camper, traveler, craftsman, and inventor. He traveled to England to discover treasures, the Nevada desert to unearth nature's wonders and his own backyard to unfold his talents. He is survived by his wife Elfie of Lafayette; their son Jim and wife Annie of Sonora; their daughter Nancy and husband of Days Creek, Oregon; 9 grandchildren and 15 great-grandchildren, loving nieces and a nephew. Aaron was preceded in death by his parents and his sisters Jean Helmick and Bonnie Salvin. Hull's Chapel in Walnut Creek will host a viewing Thursday, August 28 from 4:00pm to 8:00pm. The Funeral Service will begin at Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Lafayette at 1:00 pm Friday and will be preceded by a viewing in the Sanctuary from 11:30 am - 12:30 pm. Internment will follow immediately at The Lafayette Cemetery.
