**ROTARIANS ROLL OUT MORE FUNDRAISERS FOR ROTARY'S CHALLENGE**

Golfers did a double take when they saw golf balls falling from the sky above the driving range at Biltmore Golf Course in Coral Gables, FL, on 31 Oct.

A helicopter dropped the balls, 1,820 in all, from 100 feet above a golf pin in the middle of the range as part of a fundraiser to support Rotary's \$200 Million Challenge.

Rotarians in District 6990 (Bahamas; Florida) paid \$25 for raffle tickets that corresponded to the numbered golf balls. Winners were determined by matching the numbers on the balls closest to the pin with the numbers on the tickets.

"The first-prize winner received a trip for two to Argentina donated by a Rotarian, the second-prize winner received a Cartier watch, and the third-prize winner received a weekend stay and brunch at a local Hyatt Regency," says Noelle Galperin, District 6990 PolioPlus Subcommittee chair. The effort netted \$45,000 for the district's 2008-09 commitment of \$50,000 to Rotary's challenge.
